The Indigenous Land Corporation (ILC) assists Indigenous Australians to acquire land and manage Indigenous-held land sustainably, and to provide cultural, social, economic or environmental benefits for themselves and future generations.

Under the *National Indigenous Land Strategy 2007-2012*, the ILC gives priority to applications that:

- Deliver training and sustainable employment outcomes for Indigenous people; and
- Bring in other partners who can provide money and support to the project.

Applications to each program will be relatively assessed against these priorities and the Program Criteria. There is now an annual call for both land acquisition and land management applications.

The ILC maintains that achieving sustainable benefits through land ownership and management is a challenging and complex task, involving an array of technical, business and management skills, which in turn must be underpinned by capacity and commitment.

Consequently the ILC's land acquisition and management programs require applicants to define a specific purpose and achievable benefits. The ILC assesses all applications thoroughly and does not support those that it believes are not sustainable in the long term, or those that are inconsistent with the ILC's published Program Guidelines. Through its evaluation framework the ILC monitors active projects to see that they are sustainable and that real benefits, particularly in employment and training, are derived from land ownership.

Strategic land acquisition and land management activities have enabled the ILC to deliver important outcomes, especially in relation to economic development, employment and training, as well as providing a more effective means to help Indigenous people to address their aspirations regarding urban land issues.

A key component of these strategic projects has been the ILC's proactive development of high-level collaboration with Australian and State/Territory Government agencies, private industry, peak Indigenous organisations, communities and the non-government sector. These partnerships have attracted significant additional financial and human resources to allow long-term, sustainable programs to be developed with a focus on building capacity, equity and economic returns.

The ILC will continue the same approach to help deliver sustainable benefits in urban, regional and remote locations, and to also increase economic development, education, employment and training outcomes particularly in key industries such as pastoralism and tourism.

The ILC is keen to explore new ways of doing business in the Pilbara and will work in a cooperative manner in planning for and achieving, sustainable regional outcomes for Indigenous people of the Pilbara.

### ***Functions and Powers:***

*The Aboriginal Councils and Associations Act 1976 (the Act) confers a range of functions and powers on the Registrar who is required amongst other things to:*

- *Advise Aboriginals and Torres Strait Islanders on procedures for establishing Aboriginal councils and for the incorporation of Aboriginal associations;*
- *Process applications for incorporation and subsequent changes to names, objects and rules;*
- *Maintain public registers of Aboriginal councils and incorporated Aboriginal associations;*
- *Arbitrate in disputes within corporations in so far as they relate to the Act and the regulations, or the rules of corporations;*
- *Conduct special general meetings as provided under the Act and if considered necessary by the Registrar, particularly in relation to the resolution of disputes; and*
- *Enforce compliance with the Act by:*
  - *Monitoring the filing of documents and annual reports;*
  - *Examining corporate records;*
  - *Issuing statutory notices;*
  - *Seeking injunctions;*
  - *Initiating examinations into the operations of corporations;*
  - *Appointing (with prior ministerial approval) administrators to conduct the affairs of corporations; and*
  - *Petitioning for the winding-up of corporations.*
