

Regional Economic Development Grants

The Regional Economic Development Grants (RED Grants) program is a \$28.8 million State Government initiative that invests in community driven projects to stimulate economic growth and development in regional Western Australia.

Funding of up to \$100,000 is available for individual projects in the Pilbara that promote local sustainable jobs, recovery from COVID-19 pandemic impacts, economic diversification or expansion, skills and capability development and new investment in the region.

Who's eligible?

- local governments
- not-for-profit organisations
- Australian registered businesses
- industry associations
- incorporated bodies
- universities or training institutions (under collaborative agreements)

Regional development priorities

Applications must demonstrate how the project supports at least one of these regional development priorities:

- Prosperous and diverse economy; and
- Aboriginal economic participation and prosperity.

How to apply

Eligible applicants are encouraged to contact the Pilbara Development Commission to discuss their project proposal prior to the submission of an application.
